57% OF SOUTH AFRICAN KIDS ARE RAISED WITHOUT FATHERS

Research has shown that dysfunctional family life is the biggest problem, with fatherlessness at the centre of the problem.

In every country the following 4 issues are mentioned as the biggest problems in society. In some cases 3 more are added, namely **Drugs, Violence** and Unemployment



- 63% of suicides come from fatherless homes
- 80% of rapists motivated by displaced anger come from fatherless homes
- 70% of juveniles in state operated institutions come from fatherless homes

- 40% of all children do not live with their biological fathers.
- 85% of children with behavioural problems come from fatherless homes.
- 90% of homeless children come from fatherless homes.
- 71% of children who do not finish school come from fatherless homes.

....Virtually every major social pathology has been linked to fatherlessness: violent crime, drug and alcohol abuse, truancy, teen pregnancy, suicide—all correlate more strongly to fatherlessness than to any other single factor.

The majority of prisoners, juvenile detention inmates, high school dropouts, pregnant teenagers, adolescent murderers, and rapists all come from fatherless homes.

The connection with fatherlessness is so strong that it erases the relationships between race and crime and between low income and crime....

- Men comprise 94 percent of drunk drivers.




Nervous System Development

Brain growth in an infant's first year of life is nothing short of remarkable: the brain uses 60% of the total energy consumed by the infant and nearly triples in size. Much of the energy that fuels this growth is supplied by fat in the infant's diet, which is why breast milk is so rich in this nutrient. The child's brain has achieved 80% of its growth by age 2, though cognitive development continues far beyond that time period.






SA Population Average






Phases Of Life
